3. Consider donation and naming request for the Longest Day 10K — Dave Discussed a \$5,000 donation offer from Jacob Mills, who in turn would like to see the

Longest Day 10K named in honor of his grandfather and early club stalwart Harvey Mills.

It was agreed to gratefully accept the donation and bestow naming rights for 10 years. After which time, the Mills family could continue naming rights for an annual gift of \$500 to \$1,000. It is understood that if for any reason the race would be discontinued, the funds would be redirected to another club function.

Those present agreed that the race director should include a way to honor Harvey Mills as a part of the race, possibly in the form of a medal, a medallion or some imprinted item.

Note: Harvey was one of the club's charter members when it was formed in September 1969 and continued to be a staunch volunteer and avid runner for many years.

He is a six-time finisher of the Longest Day Marathon (the predecessor to the Brookings Marathon) and an eight-time finisher of the Jack 15 between 1970 and 1978. In 2018, as the club was conducting a scholarship fund drive, Mills provided a lead gift of \$20,000. Mills died at age 94 on Sept. 11, 2020.

Despite that and seasonally chilly weather, there were 55 walkers and runners who gathered at the swimming pool parking lot. It was decided to continue with that format.

Postmeeting follow-up: Becka Foerster has agreed to continue as director. She will make a contact to see if Hillcrest School could be opened for restroom use. Hot chocolate and a few pies for door prizes might be added, but it would remain a free and nontimed event.
