• **Arbor Day 5K** April 30 — John Blatchford reported that the city-paid ad for the race stated donations would offset the cost of the run. So \$78 received in donations was forwarded to park and recreation department with a \$50 charge added for a contribution to the Prairie Striders scholarship per club practices. He added a rebate has been received from USATF for overpayment of sanctioning.

• Brookings Marathon May 15 — Matt Bien

52nd running; 2nd pandemic edition; 25th oldest marathon in US. Now 3rd oldest continuously run marathon (after Pike's Peak - 1956 and Heart of America - 1960)

Beautiful day with light breeze and starting temps in upper 40s; little warm by the end of day for the marathon.

Marathon 159, Half Marathon 239, Relay 31 teams

Near universal positive feedback from runners; especially loved the volunteers and course Appeal of the race is the variety and grand tour of all that Brookings has to offer.

In this appeal is the inherent complexity of traffic control and volunteer support288 volunteers on the course and about 350 for race weekend in total, recruitment one of the more difficult aspects of putting on this race
